Makerere University's position on Motor cycles (Boda Boda cyclists) in the Main Campus

On Wednesday 28th July, 2010, The University Security Committee held a meeting to discuss a range of security measures, in the wake of the recent bombings, which claimed the lives of many innocent people.

As, a University, we are concerned about the security of our students and staff. In line with this, one of the security measures agreed upon during the meeting was to restrict the access by boda boda operators to the campus.

"The aim of this measure is not to inconvenience our dear staff and students, but to safeguard the University community. As an institution, we would love to maintain a safe and secure environment conducive to staff and student progress," added Ms. Ritah Namisango, Public Relations Officer, Makerere University.

The security committee decided that all boda boda operations will stop at the University gates namely the Main Gate, Eastern Gate and the Western Gate (through Sir. Apollo Kaggwa Road).

Therefore, if one wishes to access areas such as The Faculty of Law, Complex Hall, School of Education and their surroundings, they should use the Main Gate. In the event that one wants to access Faculties of Technology, Science, Forestry, the Department of Food Science and Technology, and surrounding areas, we advise them to use the Western Gate.
