RE: RESOLUTION OF COUNCIL OVER THE STUDENTS STRIKE ON TUITION FEES PAYMENT POLICY


At its emergency meeting held on Thursday, April 7, 2016, in the Council Room, the University Council considered the strike by some sections of the students' body over the Tuition Fees payment policy. Council also received presentations by the Student Leaders led by the Guild Speaker (Rt. Hon. Jothan Y. Burobuto) and the Deputy Guild Speaker (Ms. Martha Mulerwa).

After deliberations, Council resolved as follows:

1. That the Tuition Fees Payment policy be maintained until reviewed.
2. That 100% Tuition Fees be paid by the 12th week (not later than 23rd April 2016) as requested by the students but **ONLY** for this semester.
3. Students, Parents, Guardians and Sponsors are requested to crosscheck the status of tuition fees payment and ensure that the students will have fully paid 100% tuition fees by the 12th week (not later than 23rd April 2016) as there will be no further extension.
4. Any student who will not have paid 100% Tuition Fees by the 12th week shall be deemed to have withdrawn from the university.
5. Students who missed tests and course works during the two days strike (Tuesday, 5th April and Wednesday 6th April 2016) and are found not to have been involved in the strike will be given a chance to do the tests/course works.

6. The Council condemned the strike in the strongest terms, that some Government, State House sponsored students, students who had fully paid or partially paid had participated in the strike.
7. That Government/State House sponsored students who will be found to have participated in vandalism and destruction of property shall be recommended for withdrawal of their sponsorship.
8. Council resolved that any student identified to have caused damage to University property or any other property during the strike shall be required to compensate for the damages and appropriate disciplinary action taken against him/her.
9. That an investigation should start immediately and any student found to have participated in the vandalism of property shall be disciplined and made to pay for the damages.
